Whilst we presently will still be opening as scheduled on the 27th March 2020, we would ask, that out of consideration to others, you do not to come to Croft, if any of the following is applicable to you:

You have travelled to or returned from any of the following countries within the last 14 days:

Mainland China, Japan, Republic of Korea, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Taipei, Singapore, Macau, Iran, Italy, Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, Malaysia, France, Spain, Germany, Austria (Tyrol region).

You are experiencing a cough or fever/high temperature or shortness of breath, even if mild

You have been in close contact with a spouse/family member/any individual who has travelled to any of the affected countries within the stated time frame?

You are aware of being in close contact, (less than 2 meters for more than 15 minutes) with anyone who has been diagnosed with the coronavirus?

We have installed electric hand dryers in the toilets and shower blocks on Croft and all our soap dispensers are filled with anti-bacterial soap. We would therefore ask that if you do come to Croft that you follow the NHS and Government advice regarding hygiene and hand washing.

By taking these actions we are confident that all efforts have been made to present as safe an environment as possible for all. In line with the latest Government and Health Authority guidance, we will do our best to continue to operate as usual.
